Notice and Takedown Procedure for Making Claims of Infringement

What is “Notice and Takedown Procedure”?

1. If you are a rights owner and you are concerned that you have found any Content on our Environment of which you are the rights owner and for the use of which you have not given permission, you can contact us according to the following procedure. We respond expeditiously to intellectual property rights owners who complete and submit the Notice Form (below) to communicate concerns of any alleged infringement.
2. Please keep in mind that all items and information posted or offered for lease or sale through our Environment are merely hosted on BNL’s Environment and are posted solely at the discretion of the Content Providers, who may be contacted by the platform email system.

Consequences of submitting a Notice Form

3. Upon receipt of a Notice Form we may take certain actions, including removing or disabling access to Content, information or an item, all of which are taken without any admission as to liability and without prejudice to any rights, remedies or defenses, all of which are expressly reserved.
4. In submitting a Notice Form, you grant to BNL and its affiliates the right to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, translate, create derivative works from, and display the content of such notice worldwide in any media. This includes forwarding the Notice Form to the parties involved in the provision of the allegedly infringing content (i.e. the Content Provider).
5. You agree to indemnify BNL and its affiliates for all claims brought by a third party against BNL or its affiliates arising out of or in connection with the submission of a Notice Form.
6. **Important Warning:** giving false, misleading or inaccurate information in the Notice to BNL may result in civil liability. You should contact a solicitor should you have any questions.

Sending the Notice Form

7. After you have filled out the Notice Form (below), the signed form can be sent via E-mail to:

8. If you use an anonymous email service and/or we have no way to contact you back, your complaint will not be valid and will be ignored.

Counter-Notice

9. If you own the rights to Content that you have uploaded to BNL Environment and that has been taken down, you may file a Counter-Notice. To be valid, a Counter-Notice should contain the following information:

- (a) Identification of the material that has been removed or to which access has been disabled and the location at which the material appeared before it was removed or disabled;
- (b) A statement that you believe in good faith that the material was removed or disabled as a result of mistake or misidentification of the material in question and that the material is not infringing any third party rights.
- (c) Your name, address and telephone number; and
- (d) Your physical or electronic signature.

Use of BNL is subject to our [Terms Of Use](#). This Notice and Take Down Procedure is provided to complement and not to exclude your legal rights. If you are the subject of any material that is defamatory, breaches your intellectual property rights and/or is otherwise in breach of our Terms of Use then you are recommended to seek independent legal advice.

Takedown Notice Form

- (1) I am the owner, or an agent authorized to act on behalf of the owner, of certain intellectual property rights (“IP Owner”).
- (2) I have a good faith belief that the items described below or any part thereof violate(s) the intellectual property rights owned by the IP Owner or its agent, nor is such use otherwise permissible under law.
- (3) Contact information:
 - (a) Your and/or your company's name, full address, telephone number and contact email address;
 - (b) The contact email address and/or name which we will provide to Content Providers (if relevant) so they may contact you to resolve any issues regarding your notification to us. If you do not provide a separate contact email, you authorize us to use the contact information you provide in section (3)(a) above.
- (4) Description of the Allegedly Infringing Item and Allegation of Infringed Right:
 - (a) The detailed description of where the item that you claim is infringing your rights is located on the site.
 - (b) A description of your intellectual property right(s) that you claim has/have been infringed (e.g. copyright, trademark or patent) by the item.
[REPEAT (2)(a-b) as necessary for multiple items]
- (5) I represent, under penalty of perjury, that the information in this notification is true and correct and that I am the intellectual property owner or authorized to act on behalf of the intellectual property owner for the rights described above.
- (6) Sign the Notice Form (physical or electronic signature).
